FSC

Since we primarily work with reclaimed and salvaged materials, we do not currently hold an FSC Chain of Custody certification. We can and do source FSC certified lumber and composite materials. When we do use new timber, we source from trusted partners in the Midwest who follow selective, sustainable forest management practices.
