Our Live Sawn Veneer Panels, Slat Wood Wall Panels, and Solid & Reclaimed Wood products are Living Building Challenge Red List Free. Our standard finishes are also free of Red List chemicals. View our ingredient disclosures on the Declare database here.

## SOURCING

Based in the Midwest, we draw inspiration from our surrounding hardwood forests. We source many products from reclaimed and urban wood, while also prioritizing under-utilized species and lumber grown through responsible management practices. FSC-certified materials are available upon request.

## GREENGUARD

We prioritize using finishes that are UL Greenguard and UL Greenguard Gold Certified for low VOC emissions and contribute to healthy interiors.

## HEALTHY FINISHES

We collaborate closely with our finish manufacturing partners to create no-VOC and low-VOC formulas, eliminating Red List chemicals and formaldehyde. We exclusively use MDF brands that meet the Composite Panel Association's Eco-Certified Composite Standard, ensuring strict emission requirements and recycled material utilization.
